The Center for Africana Studies is pleased to announce an open competition for its majors and minors. Beginning in the Fall of 2009 and continuing until 2012, the Center for Africana Studies will select two Hopkins undergraduates who will be appointed as Ferguson Fellows. The \$1000 award is to be used to help pay for expenses related to the intersession Ghana program sponsored by the Center for Multicultural and Student Affairs, the Center for Africana Studies, and the Center for Social Concern.
