

These instructions are GUIDELINES for installing the new Canon printer drivers on Linux computers.

If you are trying to print from one of the department Linux computers, and you are having problems printing to the new printers, please send an email to [help@pha.jhu.edu](mailto:help@pha.jhu.edu) with the machine name and the printer you are trying to print to.

The Canon printers support HP JetDirect printing on Linux computers

1. Save installer file to /tmp.

2. In your particular "**Add Printer**" dialog

Add Network Printer -> AppSocket/HP JetDirect

Device URI

socket://{printer\_name}.pha.jhu.edu:9100

(eg: socket://366lp.pha.jhu.edu:9100)

printer name (366lp, for example)

use the printer name for the description field & the room # for location

Continue

Add the driver. use the "Provide a PPD File:" option

use the PPD downloaded previously  
then query printer for default options.

Finally, set the printer to be the system default.
