The Center for Language Education (CLE) in the Krieger School of Arts and Sciences at Johns Hopkins University is pleased to announce the Study Abroad Scholarship program available to students studying a language offered in CLE overseas during the academic year (fall, spring and summer). A minimum of \$1,000 will be awarded to individuals excelling in acquisition of the target language and demonstrating outstanding potential to maximize their language skills by studying abroad.

The scholarship is available for students who:

1. have studied at least one year (two terms) of a language offered in CLE (Arabic, Chinese, Hebrew, Hindi, Japanese, Korean, and Russian);
2. have already been accepted to a Study Abroad program to continue study of the language in the 2018–2019 academic year (fall, spring or summer);
3. receive a strong letter of support and recommendation from the instructor(s) of the language at CLE.

The application on the next page and supporting documents should be submitted by e-mail to the CLE office no later than:

Fall 2019 – Monday, July 29th, 2019
Spring 2019 – Monday, November 18th, 2019
Summer 2019 – Monday, April 6th, 2020

Awards will be made based on review of applications by the CLE Director and language faculty.
