The Center for Language Education (CLE) in the Krieger School of Arts and Sciences at Johns Hopkins University is pleased to announce the Study Abroad Scholarship program available to students studying a language offered in CLE overseas during the academic year (fall, spring and summer). A minimum of \$1,000 will be awarded to individuals excelling in acquisition of the target language and demonstrating outstanding potential to maximize their language skills by studying abroad.

The scholarship is available for students who:

- 1. have studied at least one year (two terms) of a language offered in CLE (Arabic, Chinese, Hindi, Japanese, Korean, and Russian);
- 2. is in full-time student status at the time of the program abroad; graduating seniors are not eligible.
- 3. receive a strong letter of support and recommendation from the instructor(s) of the language at CLE.
- 4. have already been accepted to a Study Abroad program to continue study of the language in the 2024-2025 academic year (fall 24, spring 25 or summer 25) and must also have been approved by the Global Education Office.

The application on the next page and supporting documents should be submitted by e-mail to the CLE office no later than:

Fall 2024 – Thursday, August 1st, 2024 Spring 2025 – Monday, December 2nd, 2024 Summer 2025 – Tuesday, April 1st, 2025

Awards will be made based on review of applications by the CLE Director and language faculty.
